

BONUS POINTS 2010

To help manage the uncertainties of entry scores, the ANU College of Business & Economics may offer bonus points to students who do well in both Maths and English in Year 12. You may receive up to five bonus points towards entry into an ANU College of Business & Economics degree if you:

- have completed the Australian Year 12 in 2009
- have studied Maths¹ in Year 12 and achieved a score of 60% or better
- have studied English² in Year 12 and achieved a score of 60% or better
- are an Australian or New Zealand citizen or holder of an Australian Permanent Resident Visa
- apply to study one of the following ANU College of Business & Economics degree programs via UAC:
 - Bachelor of Actuarial Studies
 - Bachelor of Business Administration
 - Bachelor of Commerce
 - Bachelor of Economics
 - Bachelor of Finance
 - Bachelor of International Business
 - Bachelor of Social Science (Honours in Actuarial Studies and Economics)
 - Bachelor of Statistics
 - Bachelor of Actuarial Studies/Bachelor of Commerce
 - Bachelor of Actuarial Studies/Bachelor of Economics
 - Bachelor of Actuarial Studies/Bachelor of Finance
 - Bachelor of Actuarial Studies/Bachelor of Statistics
 - Bachelor of Commerce/Bachelor of Economics
 - Bachelor of Commerce/Bachelor of Statistics
 - Bachelor of Economics/Bachelor of Statistics

¹ ACT Maths Methods (T-Major) and above, NSW 2U Maths and above, QLD Maths B and/or C or Maths I or II, SA/NT Maths Studies or Specialist Maths, TAS Maths Methods (MME5C) or Mathematics Specialised (MSP5C), VIC Maths Methods 3 and 4 or Specialist Maths, WA Applicable Maths or Calculus.

² English subject required for bonus points is the standard level of English (or above) that prepares you for tertiary study eg T-Major or 2 units. English as a Second Language (ESL) does not satisfy this requirement.

Bonus points are automatically applied for eligible students. Students do not need to apply for bonus points.
