

EXCHANGE PROGRAM FAQ

Q: Which overseas students are eligible to study at the ANU College of Business and Economics?

A: The College accepts overseas students for undergraduate study, and a small number of postgraduates from College-specific partner institutions only.

Q: What are the English language requirements for an overseas student to study at the ANU College of Business and Economics?

A: The College accepts the following evidence of English language competency:

IELTS Examination with a score of 6.5 (no band below 6);

TOEFL Examination with a score of 570 (230 computer-based) and a TWE of 4.5;

Diploma obtained in a High School taught in English (eg. GCE 'A' levels, SAT);

English as a mother tongue.

Q: In which ANU colleges may overseas students attend classes?

A: Primarily in the ANU College of Business and Economics. Students may attend classes in other faculties (excluding Law) on a space-available basis.

Q: Are only a limited number of students admitted to the program each year?

A: Yes. Places available for incoming exchange students are limited and students are admitted using a competitively-based selection process.

Q: When are the term dates and the application deadlines?

A: Semester 1 starts on 19 February 2007. Semester 2 starts on 16 July 2007. Usually, students need to arrive between one week to 10 days beforehand. The application deadline is 1 November (for the Semester 1 intake) and 1 May (for the Semester 2 intake).

Q: What are the main student services offered to overseas students?

A: Overseas students are offered numerous services including email accounts, mailboxes, student tutors, advisors, medical and dental care, sports facilities, career counselling, organised excursions and social activities.

Q: Is accommodation guaranteed to overseas exchange students and how much does it approximately cost?

A: Yes. Accommodation on campus is guaranteed to overseas exchange students. Generally, fully-catered accommodation costs about AUD \$240 per week.

Q: Is Health Insurance compulsory for overseas exchange students?

A: Yes. ANU organises Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for students before their arrival. Health cover costs approximately AUD \$250 for one-year.
