2010 AWARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## 1. GENERAL

### 1.1 Availability

Each year the ANU College of Business and Economics ('the College') may award up to five half tuition sponsorship scholarships ('the Scholarship/s') for international students who are applying for admission to Graduate Diploma or coursework Masters programs offered by the College for the first time. The Scholarships are highly competitive awards.

Scholarships may be offered in both first and second semesters.

### 1.2 Award

The College reserves the right to make no awards in a given year, to vary the number of awards or to make an award/s at other times in exceptional circumstances. The College reserves the right to revise the Scholarships from time to time.

### 1.3 Scholarship Value

The Scholarship provides sponsorship for half of the international student tuition fee for up to one year of a Graduate Diploma or Masters program offered by the ANU College of Business and Economics.

### 1.4 Not included

The Scholarship does NOT cover the Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) premium, the cost of study materials including textbooks, fares to and from Australia or living expenses including accommodation.

### 1.5 Eligibility

The Scholarships will be available for applicants defined as overseas students under the terms of the *Higher Education Funding Act 1988*. Dependants of the staff of diplomatic or consular missions are also eligible.

### 1.6 Selection

The Scholarships will be offered by the College based on merit from applicants who are applying for admission to the University on the basis of an appropriate tertiary qualification.

Applicants must be seeking to commence in a Graduate Diploma or coursework Masters program within the College for the first time.

The Selection Committee will consider all nominations and select scholars in order of academic merit based on achievements in their past studies.

## 1.7 Candidature

A scholar will be required to enrol full-time in a program offered to graduate international students by the College in the year of the award of the Scholarship.

Requests to vary program choice within the scholar's first semester of study (before the relevant census date) will be considered by the Dean of the College (or nominee). The Scholarship is available for one year only.

## 1.8 Deferral

Successful applicants are normally expected to take up their award offer in the semester for which it was offered. Subject to College approval the award may only be deferred for a maximum of one semester.

## 1.9 University Regulations

A scholar is subject to *The Australian National University Act 1991* as amended, and to the Statutes, Rules, Regulations and Resolutions of the University.

## 1.10 Concurrent holding of other Scholarships/Awards

The Scholarship will not be tenable with any of the following:

- an Australian Government award of equal or greater value,
- any academic award or scholarship offered by ANU of equal or greater value,
- sponsorship by any organisation of equal or greater value.

A scholar must obtain permission from the Dean of the College (or nominee) to hold any other type of award concurrently with the Scholarship. If the scholar fails to notify the College of their tenure of another award, the Dean of the College (or nominee) may determine that the Scholarship shall be refunded by the scholar to the College.

## 1.11 Publicity

It is anticipated that scholars may be requested to participate in publicity of the Scholarship Scheme from time to time. This may include publicity in the country of residence or of past education. A scholar may be contacted for an interview and photograph. The College will publicise the Scholarships by publishing the names of the Scholars. Arrangements for publicity will be made through the College.

## 2. TENURE

### 2.1 Commencement

The Scholarship commences from the first day of the first teaching period of the semester in the academic year for which it is offered, unless otherwise stated in the letter of offer or approved by the Dean of the College (or nominee).

### 2.2 Duration

The Scholarship will be provided to a full-time scholar for one year only.

## 2.3 Attendance

A scholar is expected to be in attendance at the University at the commencement of the teaching period and to remain in full-time enrolment during the University teaching periods or semesters. Absences from the University through illness or for any other reason must be approved by the Dean of the College (or nominee).

## 2.4 Level of Performance

Scholars are expected to achieve at least an average of 70% in the first semester of the tenure of the scholarship. Scholars who undertake combined programs will be expected to obtain an average of 70% in the first semester of the tenure of the Scholarship across all courses taken.

Scholars who do not achieve this result in their first semester will not receive the scholarship for their second semester of study.

## 2.5 Termination

A Scholarship normally terminates at the conclusion the first two semesters of a scholar's enrolment in the program for which it has been awarded, or on the date on which the scholar ceases to attend the University other than for approved absences, whichever is the earlier. The College may terminate a Scholarship before this time if the scholar does not fulfil her or his obligations or if, in the opinion of the Dean of the College (or nominee), satisfactory academic progress in the approved program is not being made by the scholar.

## 2.6 Degree Program Changes

In the case of a scholar changing degree programs to a degree offered by a College other than the ANU College of Business and Economics, the scholarship will be terminated.

## 3. VISA

### 3.1 Permanent Residency

Scholars who obtain Australian permanent residence will cease to be eligible to hold the award from the end of the semester in which they receive permanent resident status.

### 3.2 Employment

Students must comply with the student visa regulations and are required to obtain a permission to work visa from the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) prior to obtaining any employment.

The award of a Scholarship does not carry any commitment by the University with regard to future employment.

## 4. ACCOMMODATION
