TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AWARD – 2010

1. GENERAL**1.1 Availability**

Each year the ANU College of Business and Economics ("the College") may award up to thirty (30) awards known as the ANU College of Business and Economics Student Support Award ("the Award") for Australian students who are applying for admission to the University for the first time ("the scholar"). The awards are competitive, and based on academic merit.

In 2010, the award will be offered to applicants who have been schooled in and reside in the following states:

- Queensland
- Victoria, and
- New South Wales (excluding students from the Canberra region ie Queanbeyan, Karabar, Sutton, Bungendore or Murrumbateman).

The Award will be offered in first semester only, as defined in the *University Calendar*.

1.2 Award

The College reserves the right to make no awards in a given year, to vary the number of awards or to make an award/s at other times in exceptional circumstances. The College reserves the right to revise the awards from time to time.

1.3 Award Value

The ANU College of Business and Economics Student Support Award for 2010 is an amount of \$500.

This is payable by Electronic Funds Transfer to a nominated bank account for Australia Citizens and Australian Permanent Residents.

1.4 Fees

The scholar is responsible for making payment or deferring payment of all his/her tuition fees by the prescribed dates, given in the *University Calendar*.

1.5 Other Costs

Scholars are responsible for the costs of books, study materials, accommodation, and all other costs of study.

1.6 Eligibility

- Australian Citizens and holders of an Australian Permanent Resident visa are eligible to be considered.
- Applicants must have completed a Year 12 qualification in Australia.
- Applicants must apply to ANU through the Universities Admissions Centre (UAC) and have an approved Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) or equivalent score of 92.00 or above to be considered. Direct applicants are not eligible.

- Applicants must be from the following states: Queensland, Victoria, or New South Wales (excluding students from the Canberra region ie Queanbeyan, Karabar, Sutton, Bungendore or Murrumbateman).
- Students must be entering university for the first time. Students transferring from other universities are not eligible.
- Students must complete and submit an application form by the nominated deadline, along with a statement of need/motivation of no more than 500 words to support their application.

1.7 Selection

The selection committee will make its recommendation for the award based on academic merit, statement of need/motivation and home address as listed on the students' UAC application. Scholars will be selected from applicants who are eligible to be considered in accordance with Clause 1.3 above.

1.8 Candidature

A scholar will be required to be enrolled in a single degree or combined degree program offered to undergraduate students by the College in the semester of the award. Requests to vary program choice within the scholar's first semester of study (before the relevant census date) will be considered by the Dean of the College.

The award is payable one time only and is not renewable.

1.9 Deferral

Scholars are expected to take up their award offer in the semester for which it was offered. There is no option for deferral under any circumstance.

2. TENURE

2.1 Commencement

The award will be payable after the Census Date of the semester in which it was awarded.

2.2 Duration

The Award is a single award payable one time only, to each scholar.

2.3 Concurrent holding of other Awards/Scholarships

A scholar must obtain permission from the Dean of the College to hold any other type of award or scholarship concurrently with the Award. If the scholar fails to notify the College of their tenure of another award or scholarship the Dean of the ANU College of Business and Economics may determine that the ANU College of Business and Economics Student Support Award shall be refunded by the scholar to the College.

2.4 Termination

The University may terminate the Award at any time and at the University's sole discretion if the conduct of the scholar is deemed to be unsatisfactory.

3. OTHER

3.1 Publicity

It is anticipated that Scholars may be requested to participate in publicity of the award scheme from time-to-time. This may include publicity in the region of residence or of schooling. A scholar may be contacted for an interview and photograph. The College will publicise the Award by publishing the names of the Scholars. Arrangements for publicity will be made through the College.

3.2 University Regulations

A scholar is subject to *The Australian National University Act 1991* as amended, and to the Statutes, Rules, Regulations and Resolutions of the University.

3.3 Employment

The award does not carry any commitment by the University for future employment.

3.4 Taxation Implications

It is the scholar's responsibility to determine the taxation implications of the award, if any, which apply to his/her individual circumstances.

4 ACCOMMODATION
